

## <u>ORDER</u>

WHEREAS, the government has obtained the above-captioned search warrant directed to Google Inc. ("Google"), and

WHEREAS, the above-captioned search warrant was accompanied by a nondisclosure order pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2705 that has since expired, and

WHEREAS, based on the record before the Court, disclosure to the subscriber under the terms of this Order is not likely to cause any of the adverse consequences listed in 18 U.S.C. § 2705(b), it is hereby

ORDERED that Google may deliver solely to its affected subscriber a copy of this order and the above-captioned search warrant related to the subscriber's Google account, including its Attachment A and the first page but not subsequent pages of its Attachment B, from which the name of the email account and the name of the attesting official must be redacted. Google may disclose the name of the email account to the subscriber, and the subscriber is not prohibited from further disclosure of the material that Google discloses to the subscriber pursuant to this order; it is also

ORDERED the record in matter No. 1:11 SW 594 remains under seal, and no part of it may be disclosed without court order except to the extent provided above.
